INITIATIVE PETITION

To: The Honorable Lawrence Denney, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho:

"We, the undersigned citizens and qualified electors of the State of Idaho, respectfully demand that the following proposed law, to-wit:

AN INITIATIVE TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE SHALL AMEND ITS STATE PLAN TO EXPAND MEDICAID ELIGIBILITY TO CERTAIN PERSONS.

1 AN INITIATIVE RELATING TO MEDICAID; AMENDING CHAPTER 2, TITLE 56, IDAHO CODE, BY
2 THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 56-267, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE
3 SHALL AMEND ITS STATE PLAN TO EXPAND MEDICAID ELIGIBILITY TO CERTAIN
4 PERSONS AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE IS
5 REQUIRED AND AUTHORIZED TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT
6 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION; AND AMENDING SECTION 56-262, IDAHO CODE, TO
7 PROVIDE A CORRECT CODE REFERENCE.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Chapter 2, Title 56, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
10 amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and designated
11 as Section 56-267, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

12 56-267. MEDICAID ELIGIBILITY EXPANSION. (1) Notwithstanding any provision of law
13 or federal waiver to the contrary, the state shall amend its state plan to expand Medicaid
14 eligibility to include those persons under sixty-five (65) years of age whose modified adjusted
15 gross income is one hundred thirty-three percent (133%) of the federal poverty level or below
16 and who are not otherwise eligible for any other coverage under the state plan, in accordance
17 with sections 1902(a)(10)(A)(i)(VIII) and 1902(e)(14) of the Social Security Act.

18 (2) No later than 90 days after approval of this act, the department shall submit any
19 necessary state plan amendments to the United States Department of Health and Human
20 Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to implement the provisions of this
21 section. The department is required and authorized to take all actions necessary to implement
22 the provisions of this section as soon as practicable.

23 SECTION 2. That Section 56-262, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
24 amended to read as follows:

25 56-262. DEFINITIONS. The definitions contained in section 56-252, Idaho Code, shall
26 apply to sections 56-260 through ~~56-266~~ 56-267, Idaho Code. END.

shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the State of Idaho, for their approval or rejection at the regular general election, to be held on the 6th day of November, A.D. 2018, and each for himself says: I have personally signed this petition; I am a qualified elector of the State of Idaho; my residence and legislative district are correctly written after my name.”
